◆課程大綱 Syllabus

一.課程目標 Goal	中	本課程目標為通過閱讀，討論和寫作，提高學生的英語能力，鼓勵學生於更深的層次欣賞文學，讓學生了解西方思想，並幫加強對其之理解。
	英	To improve student English ability through reading, discussion, and writing. To encourage students to enjoy literature at a deeper level. To expose students to western thought and help them understand it better.
二.先修科目 Pre-requisite	中	未通過大一英語者不建議選修本課程。
	英	Students who have not passed Freshman English are discouraged from taking this course.
三.課程大綱 Outline	中	上半年的學期中，適宜教授廣泛文學類型（小說，非小說，詩歌，短篇小說等），也會視需求節錄精選的作品文學。後半年的學期中，教師可集中在一個特定類型的文學，例如短篇小說。
	英	In the first half of the semester, a broader focus on literature (fiction, non-fiction, poetry, short stories, etc.) may be appropriate, taking excerpts and selected pieces of literature as desired. In the latter half of the semester, teachers may want to focus in on one specific type of literature, e.g. a short novel.

六.教學方式 Teaching Approach	中	在這個課程中，學生熟悉各種基本文學型式，獲得基本文獻分析能力，以便理解和幫助課堂討論。課程將包括小組閱讀，小組討論，講課（這意味著記筆記），以及其他各種適當的活動。
	英	In this course, students will become familiar with the basic kinds of literature and gain a basic grasp of literature analysis in order to facilitate understanding and aid in classroom discussion. Classes will consist of group reading, group discussion, daily lectures (which implies note-taking), and various other appropriate activities. All learning will be done in an English environment, which means the use of Chinese by both teachers and students is kept to a bare minimum. Failure to speak English will result in a lower grade.
